On Saturday, St Kilda Festival crew will be wearing this burnt orange shirt

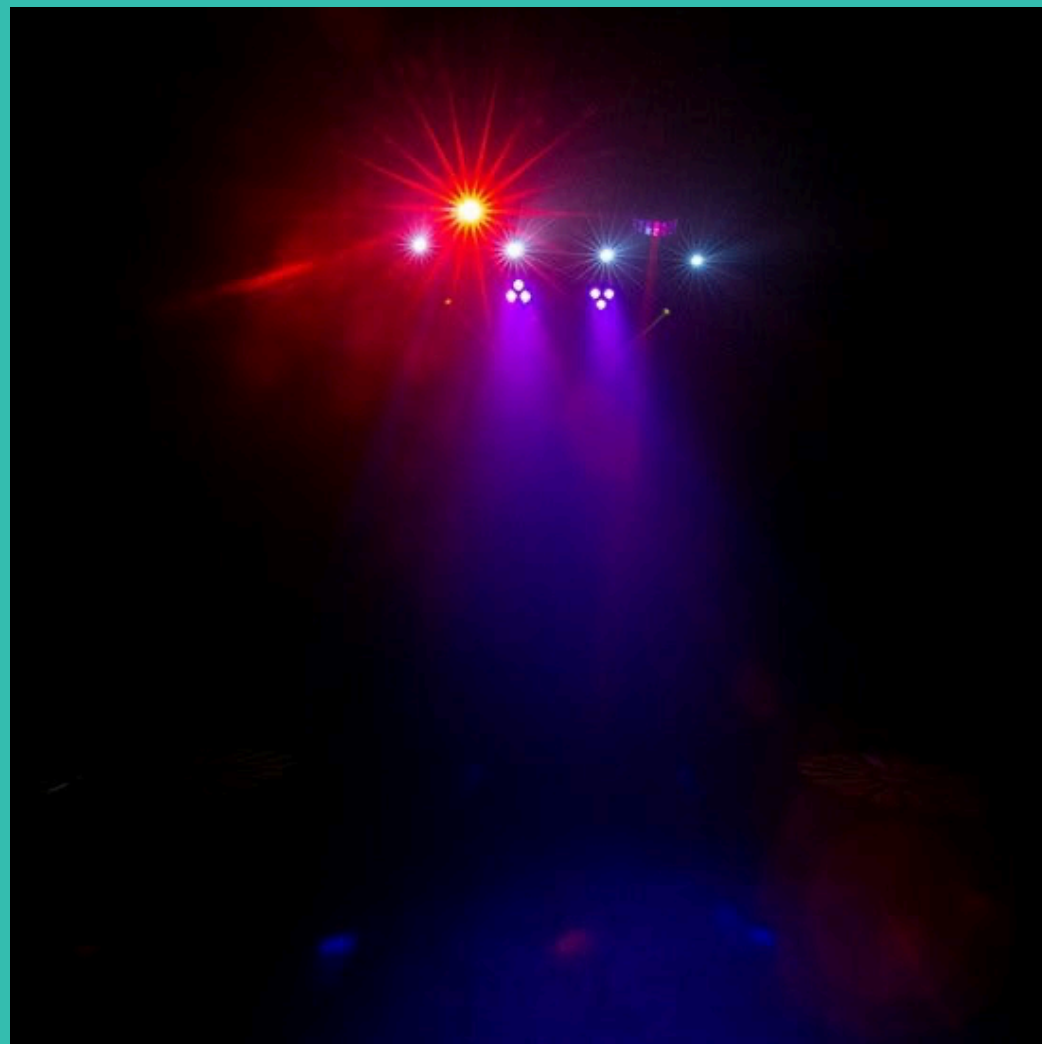


On Sunday, St Kilda Festival crew will be wearing this navy blue shirt
